Synopsis of the Exhibit

Following entry into World War II on the side of Adolph Hitler, Italy had numerous reasons to seek assistance from the Geneva Red Cross.

Strict application of classic postal history methodology (rates, routes, markings) to the relevant mail provides an observer a complete understanding of Italy's relationship with the Red Cross.
